

## Financial Aid for 2009-2010 CCSU MAT Students

The TEACH grant program is available to CCSU MAT students who are fully admitted to the 2009-2010 cohort in English, math, sciences, Spanish, or technology education. The TEACH grant program offers loans that become grants if the recipient teaches in a high need field in a high need school for at least 4 years. (All MAT content areas are currently designated as high need fields in CT.) MAT students may receive up to two \$4000 TEACH grant awards during the MAT program. The first award would be available in summer 2009 and the second would become available in spring 2010. TEACH grant recipients must maintain a GPA of at least 3.25 throughout the MAT program and attend an exit counseling session scheduled by the program coordinator in Summer I 2010.

If the TEACH grant program's conditions for service and timely documentation are not met the "grants" will retroactively revert to unsubsidized loans. The program has a number of requirements and conditions that students should closely examine with a financial aid officer.
